


British Headquarters Map 1782

- This map, drawn by British military cartographers toward the end of the American Revolution, shows the farms, country roads, isolated homesteads, fortifications, and the "town of New York" (in pink blocks on the left) in 1782 or 1783, but it is most precious as a record of the varied geography of the island.

The Commissioners' Plan of 1811

The 1811 Commissioners plan mapped the grid system north of North Street (now known as East Houston Street).

- The avenues were mapped at a width of 100 feet and the streets were mapped at a width of 60 feet, except for main cross streets (14th, 23rd, 34th, 42nd, 57th, 72nd, 79th, 86th, 96th, 106th, 116th, 125th, 135th, 145th and 155th Streets) which were mapped at a width of 100 feet. Each block was mapped with the dimension of 200 feet by 800 feet. Since the 1811 Commissioners' Map there have been over 3000 alteration maps legally adopted by the City of New York for the Borough of Manhattan, affecting various parts of the borough, but all based on the original map.



Explanation

- The Streets, Avenues and Roads laid out by the Commissioners of the Central Park, and the 6th and 7th Avenues and the Circle at 8th Av & 59th St. as widened and laid out by the Legislature, are shown in Red
- The Streets widened by said Commissioners are shown in Blue
- The Public Squares and Places laid out by said Commissioners are shown in Green
- The New Pier and Bulkhead Lines laid out by said Commissioners are shown in words and red lines
- The parts of former Streets, Avenues and Roads not shown on the Map are abandoned and closed
- The figures in red, thus 91 show the elevation of the natural Surface above high water.








Robinson Map from 1885
